### About

Camera Prep Technician Apprentices work in the media rental industries including the camera hire companies who supply camera equipment for Film, TV, Music Promos, Commercials, Documentaries, Virals and all sorts of productions. Apprentices learn how to prepare camera equipment that is complete, works effectively, is correctly maintained and is set up and has all accessories to be ready to use on a production or event. Apprentices spend most of their time at work and the equivalent of one day a week studying at London Screen Academy for around 2 years.



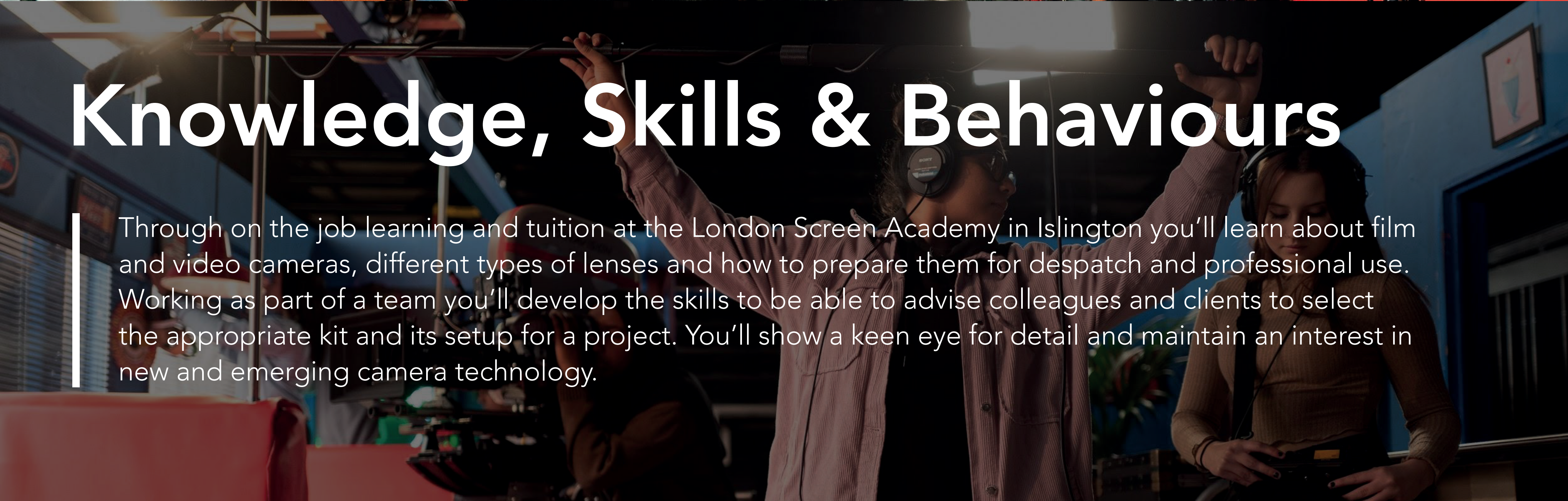
# Qualifications

If you've already got GCSE English and Maths you're well set! If you're waiting on your results, tell us what your predicted grades are when you apply. The apprenticeship is equivalent to a Level 3 qualification like A Levels or Extended Diplomas, BTECs, etc. If you've got a Level 3 qualification or above you should apply and we'll assess if you're eligible for the programme. We expect most Level 3 graduates to be eligible, but if you've got a degree in film/TV production you might not be. If you've got an Educational Health Care Plan or British Sign Language qualification you can tell us about that too on your application.



# Knowledge, Skills & Behaviours

Through on the job learning and tuition at the London Screen Academy in Islington you'll learn about film and video cameras, different types of lenses and how to prepare them for despatch and professional use. Working as part of a team you'll develop the skills to be able to advise colleagues and clients to select the appropriate kit and its setup for a project. You'll show a keen eye for detail and maintain an interest in new and emerging camera technology.
